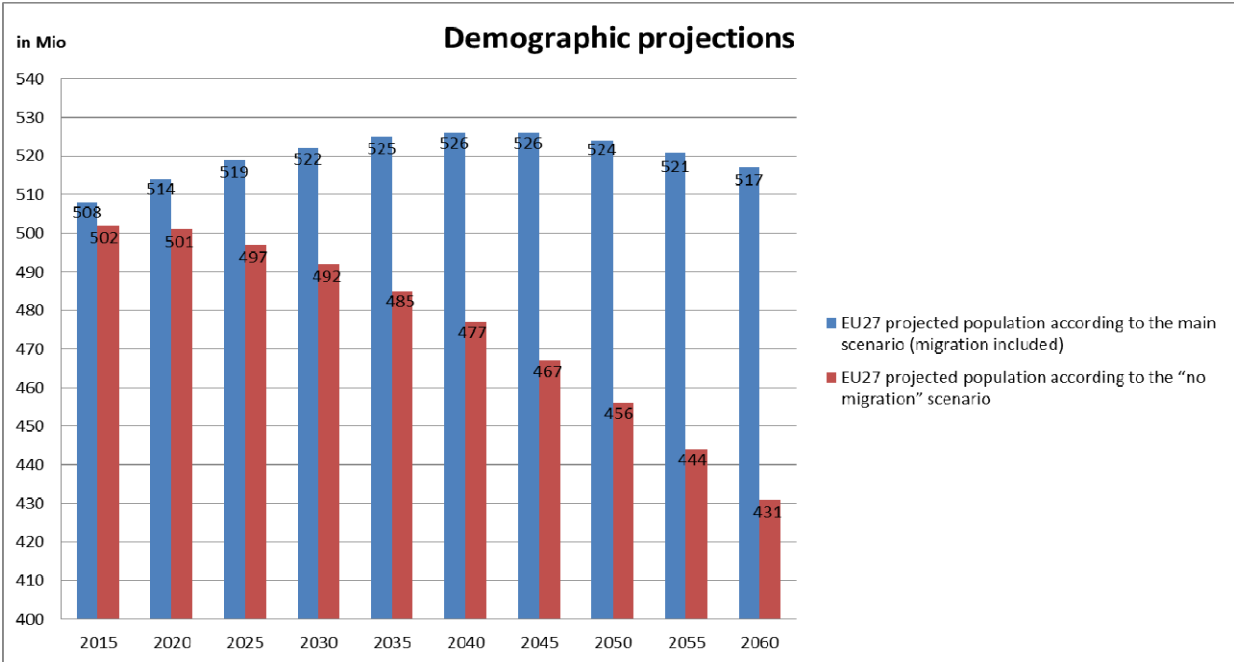

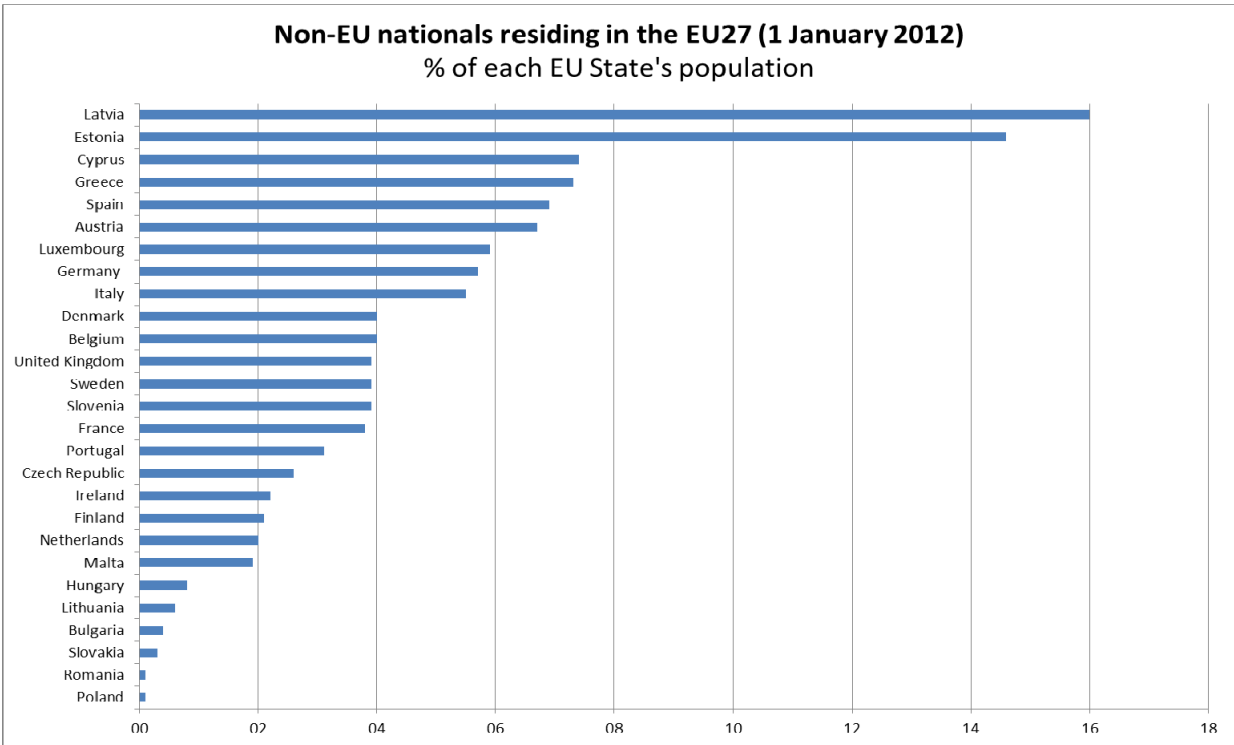

1. Demographic projections



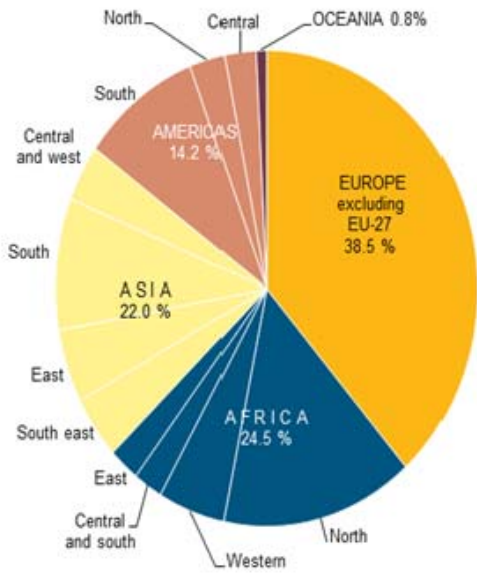

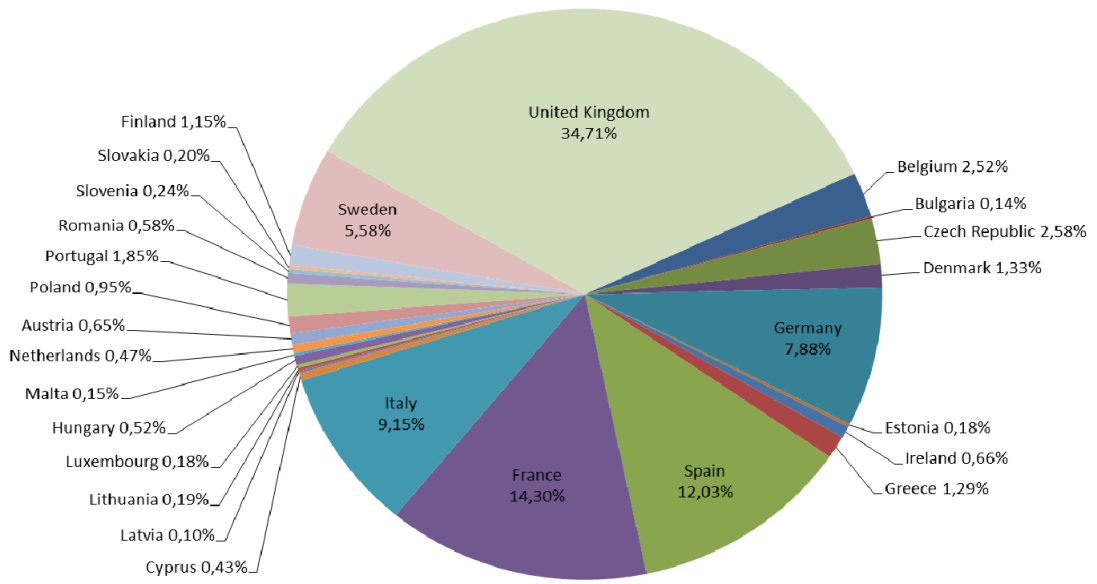

**Origin of non-EU nationals residing in the EU by continent**

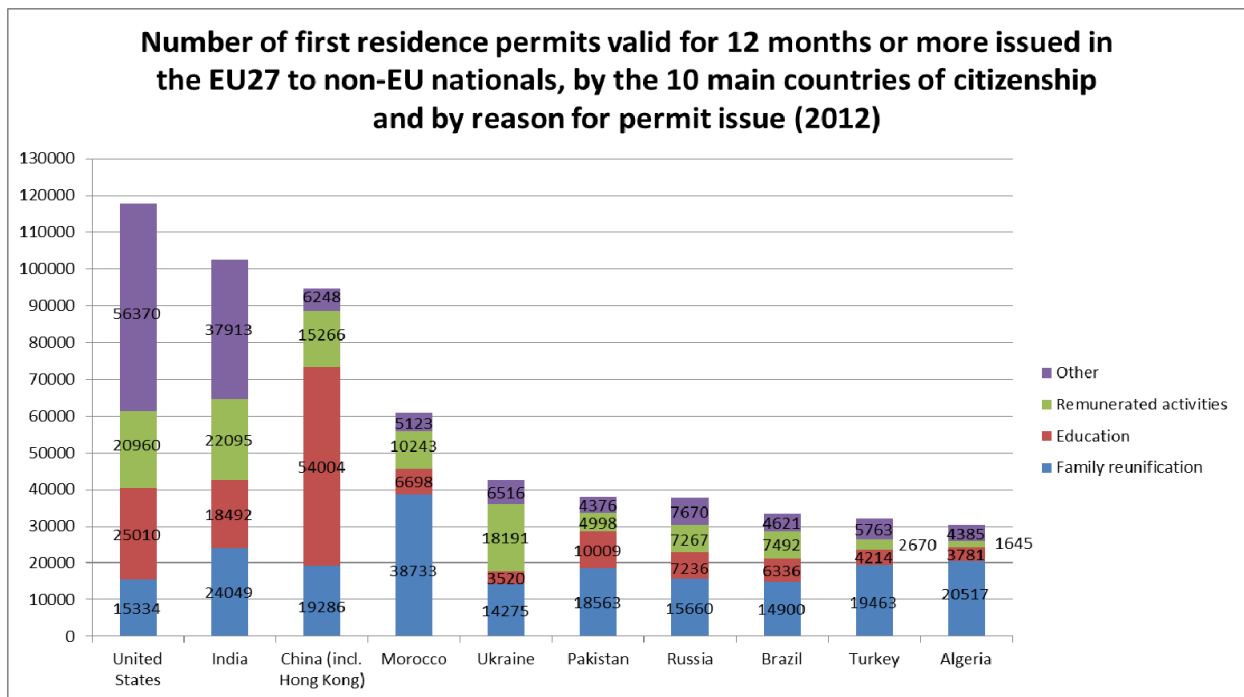

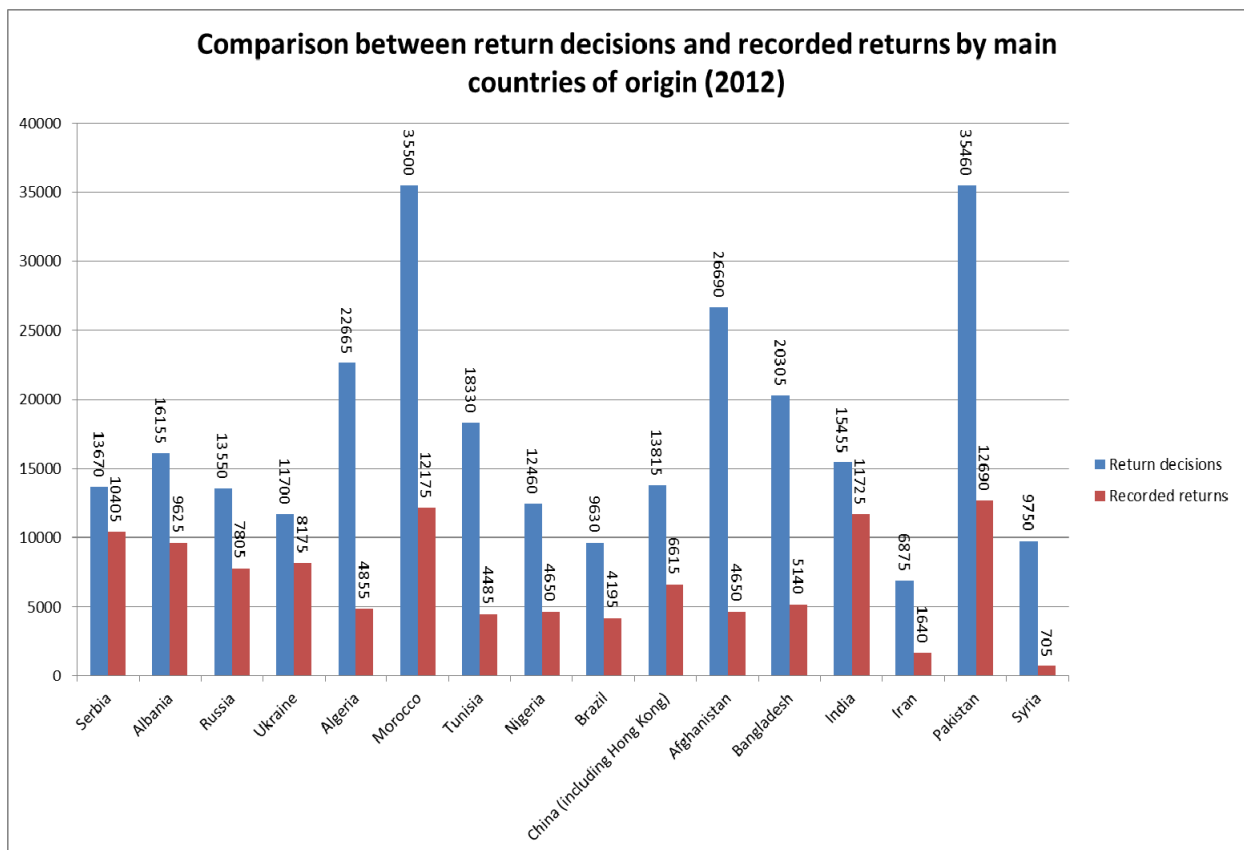
**Share by EU State of first residence permits valid for 12 months or more issued to non-EU nationals (2012)**

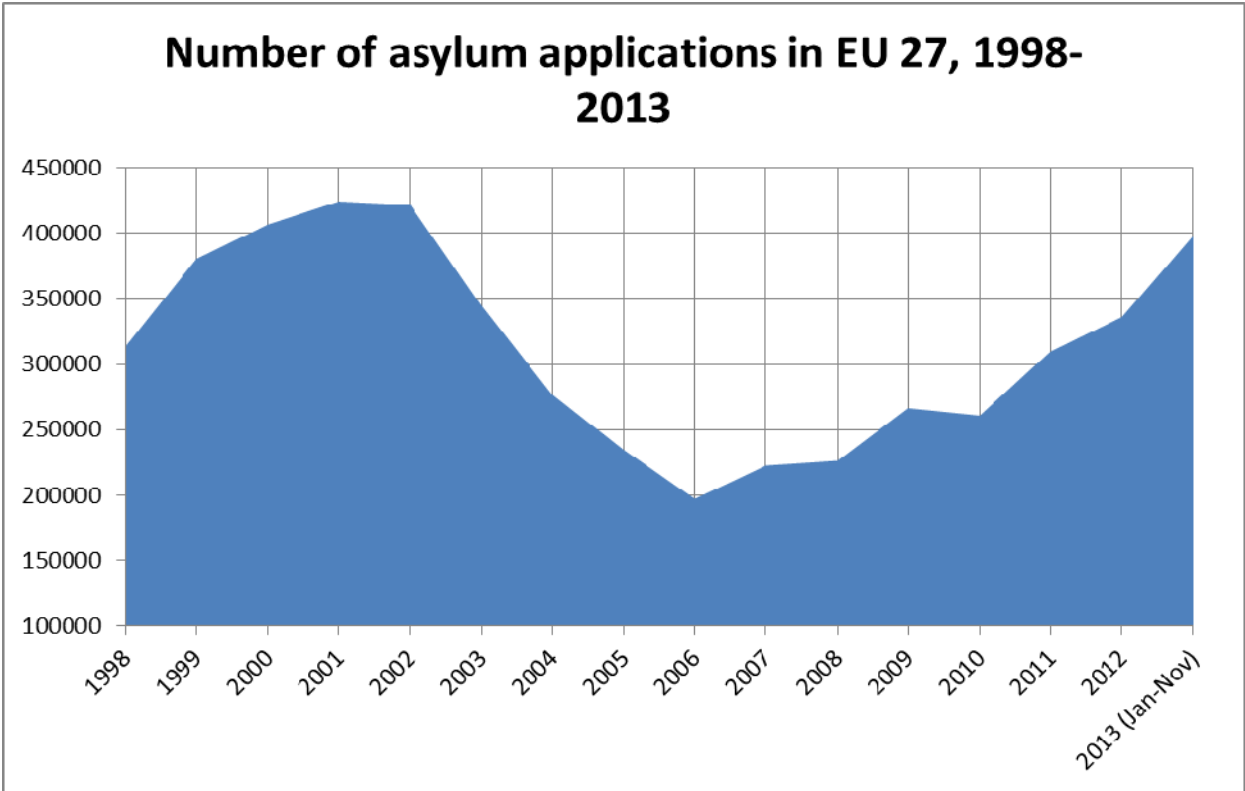

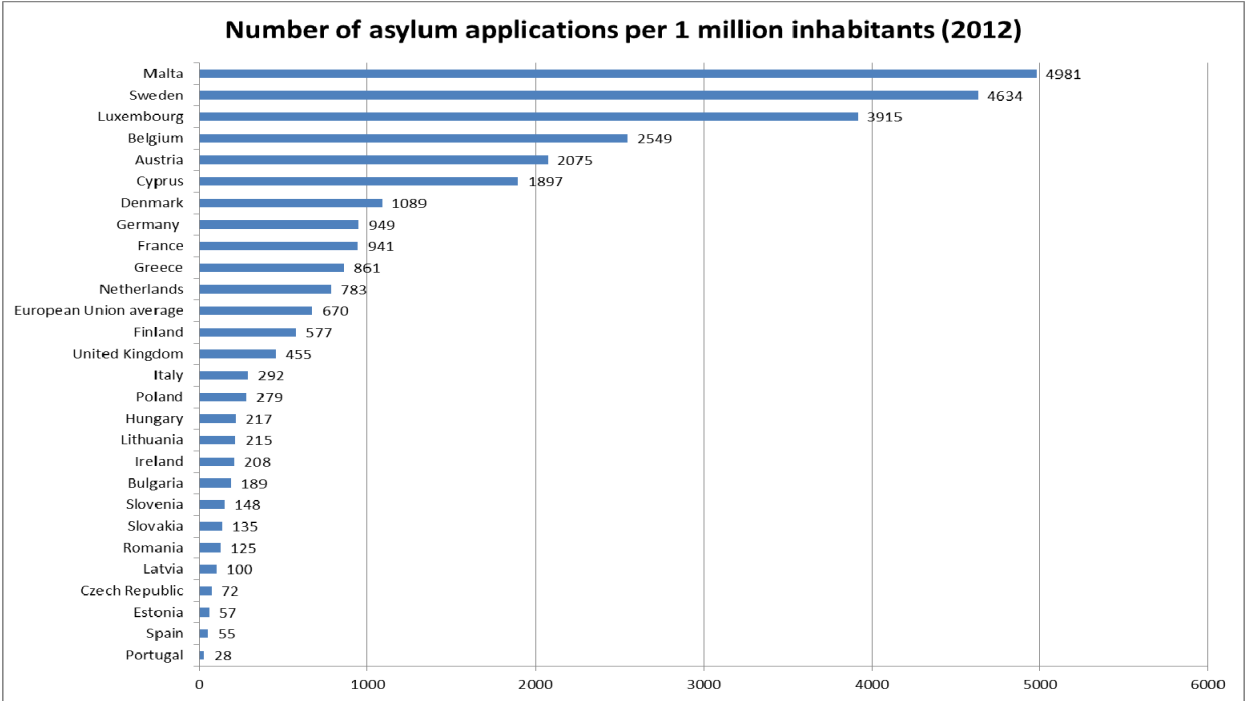

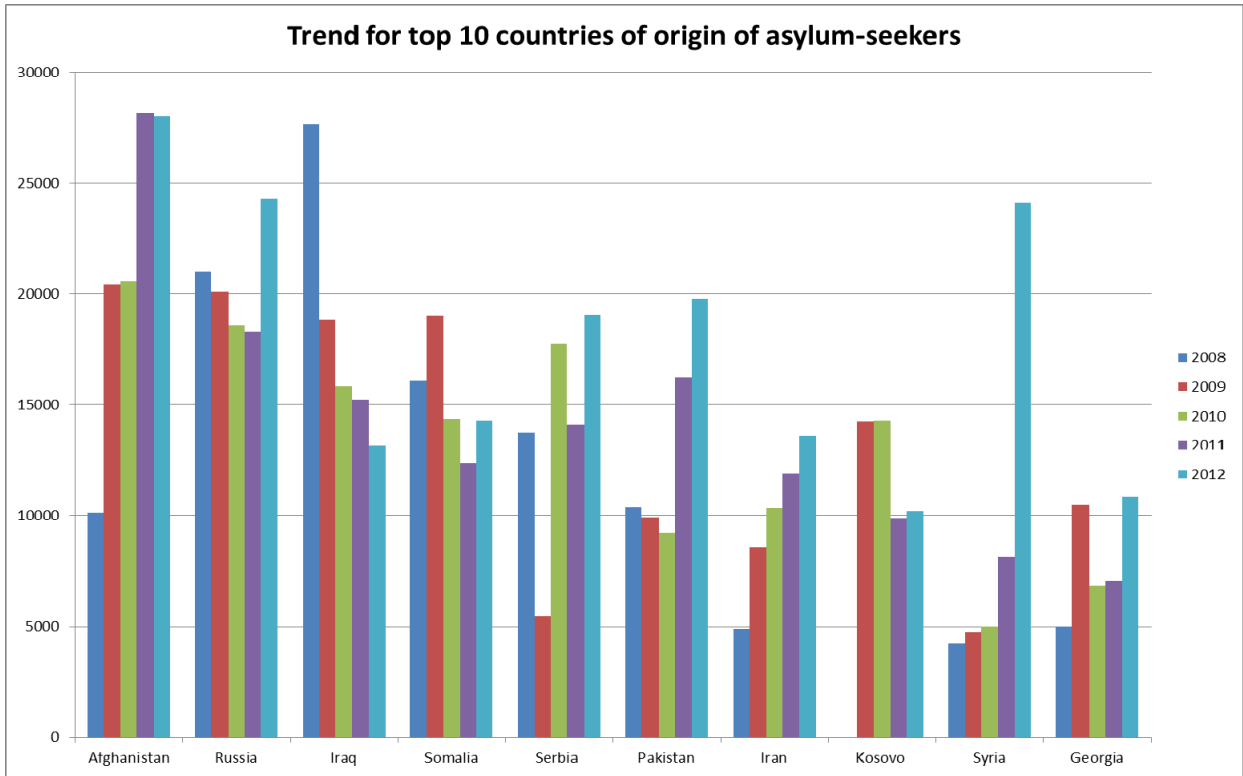

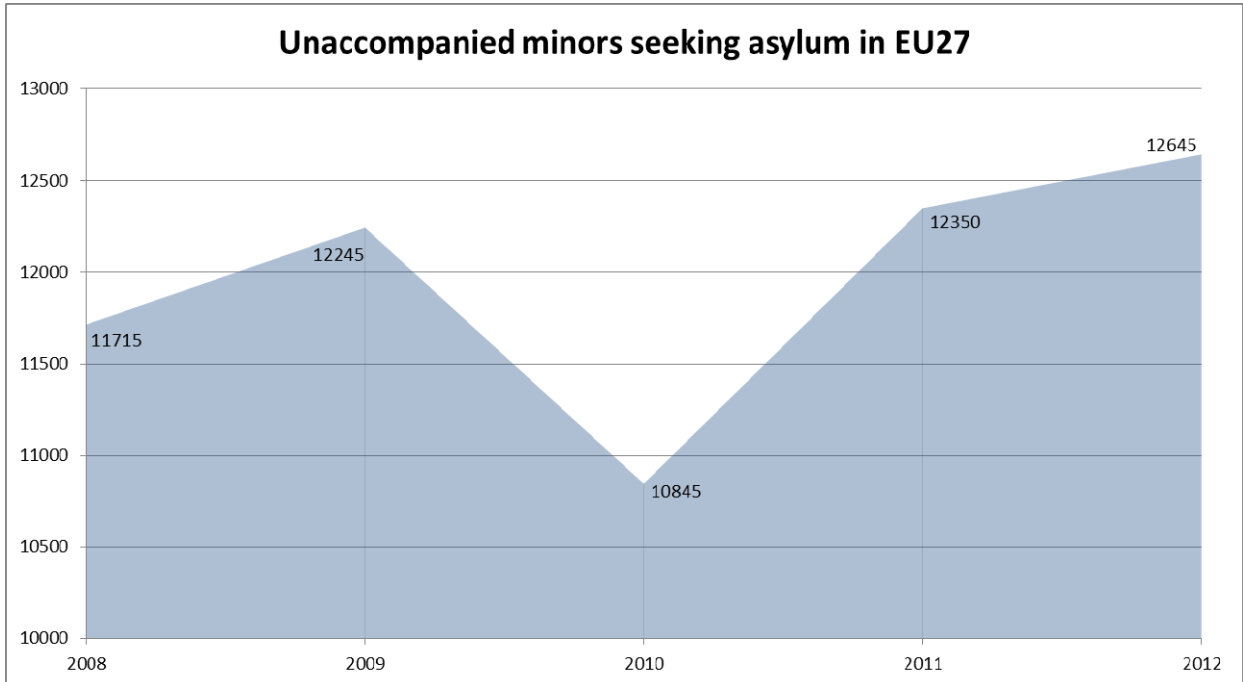

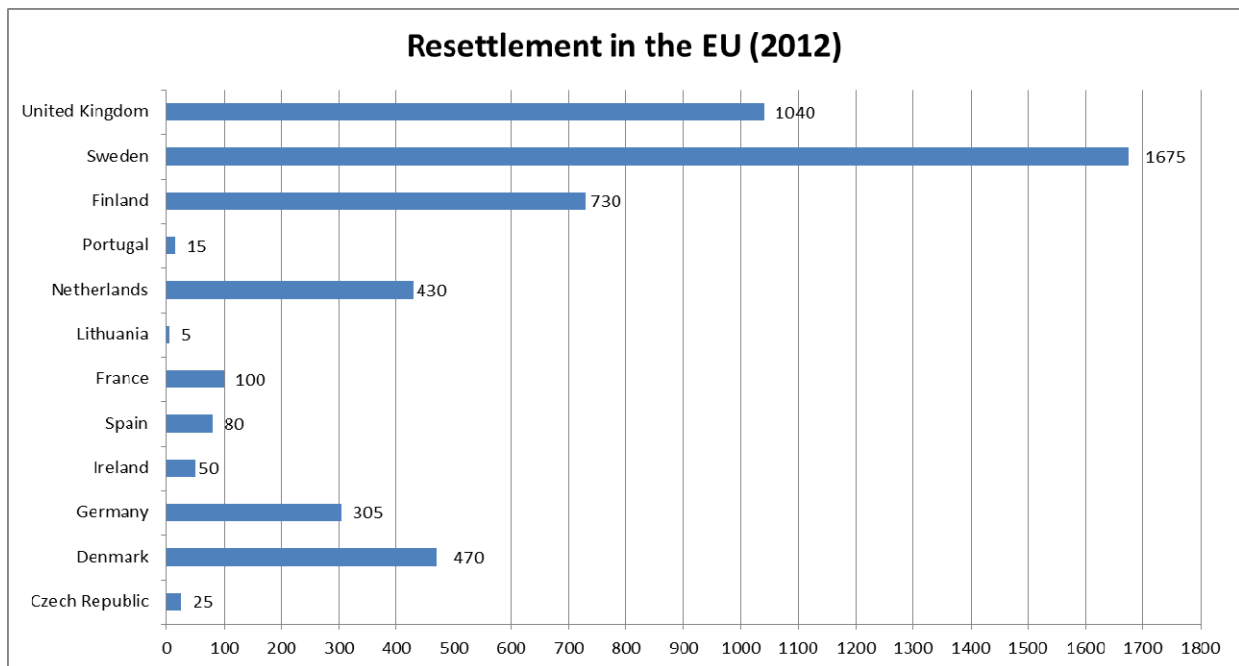

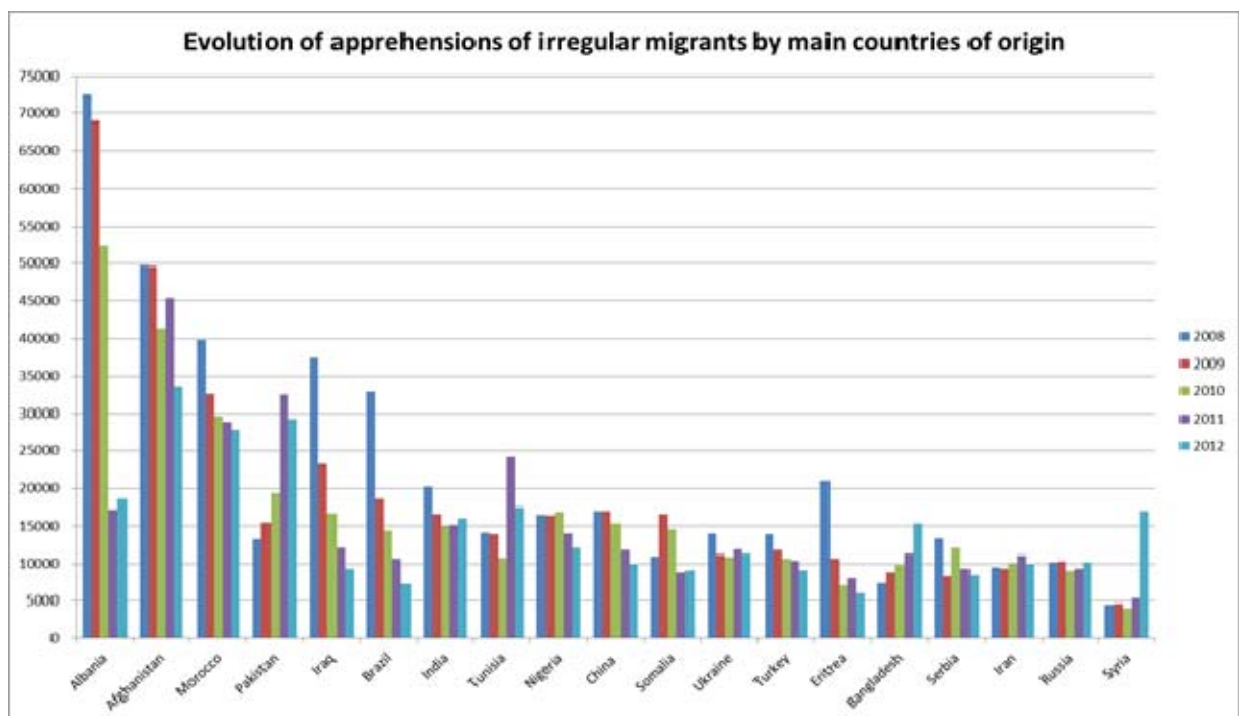

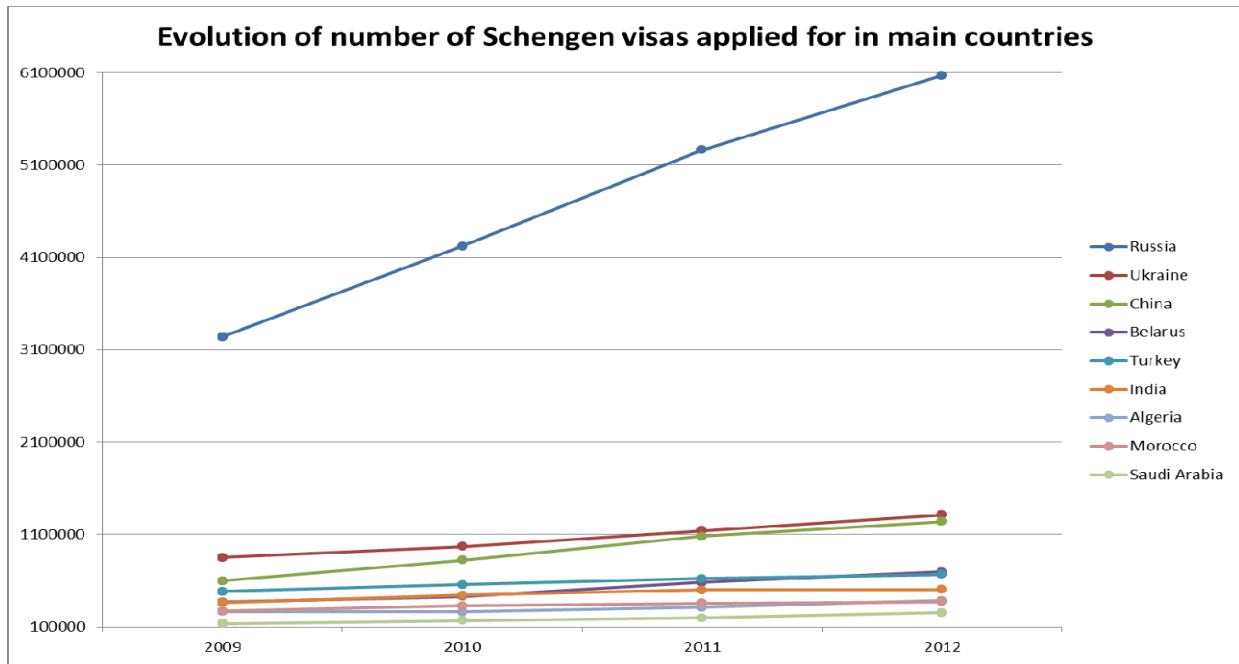

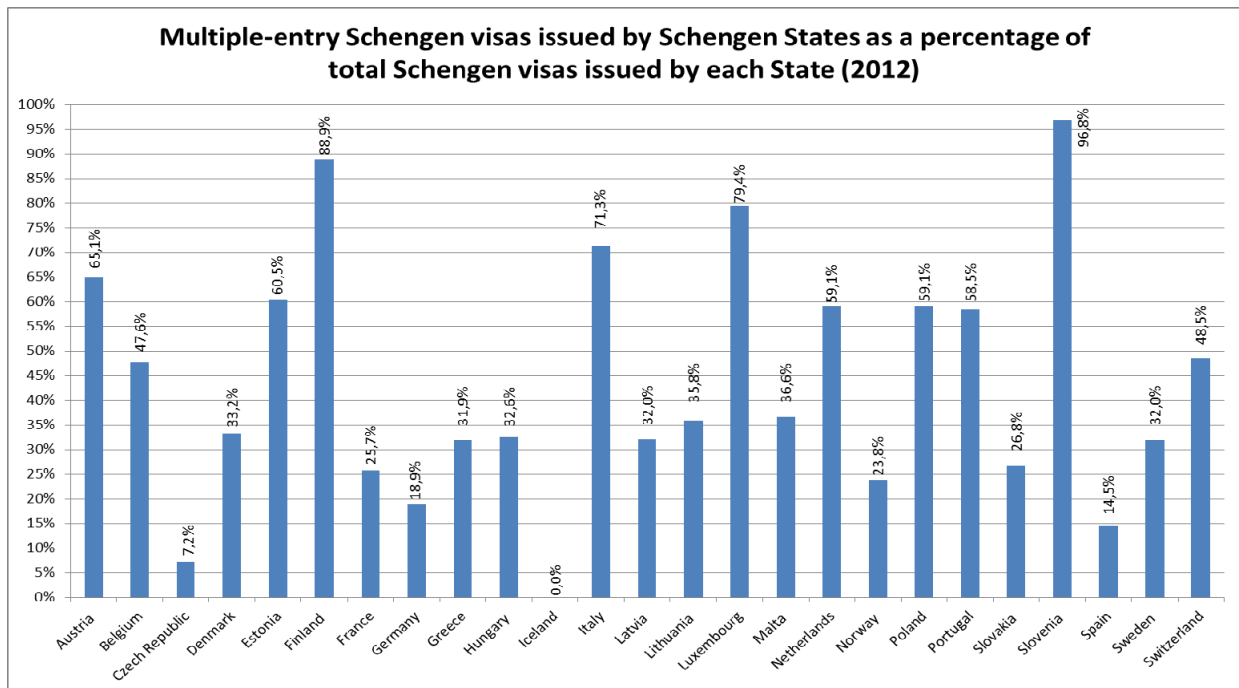
